

Conclave Music Business Scholarship to Media Institute. Since 1979, the non-profit Conclave - in keeping with its mission of educating the broadcast industry - has been awarding scholarships to deserving students desiring an education inside the radio and music industries. Included in the scholarships offered by the Conclave is an award to full-time students in the Media Institute's Recording and Music Technology program at either their Madison, WI or their Minneapolis, MN campus. The award will be a \$4000.00 tuition waiver for up to four semesters (it cannot be applied retroactively to tuition from semester prior to the award)

Eligibility.

- 1) Acceptance to the Media Institute for enrollment in the 2012 - 2013 school year or certification from the college registrar that you are enrolled full-time and currently have a 3.0 GPA or higher.
- 2) Certification from the Media Institute financial aid office that you have financial need (definition of 'financial need': you must be eligible to receive a Pell Grant).
- 3) Submit a complete application and include all requested materials, including the all-important application essay (details below).

Other Rules & Conditions.

- 1) Employees of MMI and their immediate families are not eligible to apply. Conclave Board of Directors, Executive Committee, and administrative staff members and their immediate families are also not eligible to apply.
- 2) The winning applicant must be prepared to start at the Media Institute no later than the Summer semester 2013.
- 3) Your application materials must be delivered (by mail, FedEx, etc.) to: The Conclave Media Institute Scholarship, 4517 Minnetonka Blvd, #104, Minneapolis, MN 55416. The Conclave is not responsible for applications lost in the delivery process.
- 4) All entries must be postmarked no later than March 2, 2012 and must be received no later than March 9, 2012. Only one (1) scholarship application per person will be accepted, and all application materials become property of the Conclave upon receipt. Incomplete entries will not be judged. The decision of the Conclave to award this scholarship is final.
- 5) The winner's decision to accept the scholarship must be made no later than 48 hours after notification. The scholarship cannot be sold or transferred. Winners must continue their education until graduation, or they may become liable to repay tuition monies used to the point of their departure from school.
